- 1) Habit
- 2) Flowering branch
- 3) Opened (dissected) flower (3 sepals and 2 petals removed) showing position of nectary and androecium
- 4-5) Petal - 4: inside and 5: side view (showing the form and position of nectary)
- 6-7) Androecium - 6: short style type and 7: long style type
- 8) Ovary (3 loculi)
- 9) Gynoecium: 2 loculi opened to show embryo sac (only one bundle of anthers shown)
- 10) Detail of ovary: 1 loculus with 2 seeds
- 11) Capsule
- 12) 2 mature seeds from one loculus
- 13) Vertical section of seed (with elaiosome)
